December 8-22 the Y will continue to accept donations towards books; however, personal purchases must conclude by December 7 in order to meet the holiday delivery schedule.

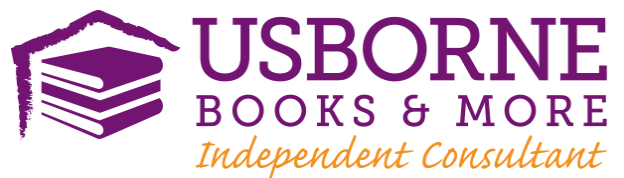
On-Site Book Purchases: December 4, 6 and 7
