DAY CAMP DIRECTOR

WHEN: May 28, 2019 to August 23, 2019

MINIMUM AGE: 20 Years of age (21 PREFERRED)

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: High School Diploma, Good leadership, organizational, and customer service skills, clean driving record (May transport campers and/or staff)

SALARY: \$300.00 to \$375.00 a week, live on site 6 days, live off site 5 days

BENEFITS: Meals, Housing if living on site

DESCRIPTION: This position requires very strong leadership, organization and communication skills. Responsible for program development, scheduling daily day camp activities, field trips and supervising all staff and day campers. Day camp is comprised of 80 to 100 day campers from first to sixth grade and Teen Adventure Camp, grades 7th through 9th grade. You must be a positive role model and work closely with the camp leadership team to ensure high quality programming that meets the expectations of our families, campers and staff. Responsible for staff observations and evaluations. **Hours will very due to responsibilities and ensuring coverage of sign in, sign out, transportation and bus stop duties.**

Must be able to provide a structured, safe experience and meet the needs of campers. Will work with the Day Camp Director and kitchen staff to plan and execute weekly field trips. **Scheduled activities will be from Monday to Friday, hours will vary due to additional responsibilities such as; camp sign in, sign out, transportation and/or bus stop supervision.**

CABIN COUNSELOR (RESIDENT CAMP)

Minimum Age: 18 years old

Special Requirements: High School Diploma Preferred, **Must reside in a Cabin with Campers**

Salary: \$225.00 to \$250.00 per week, 6 days a week

Description: Live with and supervise a group of campers, first through sixth grades. This position requires that you are a positive role model for campers, work closely with directors, other counselors, specialists and volunteers. Leading, general problem solving, planning and assisting camp activities, skits, games, singing, dancing, acting and evening programs. Providing supervision during meals, pool and waterfront activities. Daily chores and duties are required.

TEEN EXTREME COUNSELOR (RESIDENT CAMP)

Minimum Age: 19 years of age (21 preferred)

Special Requirements: High School Diploma, Clean Driving Record (Must Transport Campers), Outdoor Camping and Hiking Experience, **Must reside in a Cabin with Campers**

Salary: \$225.00 to \$250.00 per week

Benefits: Housing and Meals. Must reside site in Teen Extreme Cabin with campers

Description: Teen Extreme Counselors will work with camper's grade 7 through 9, along with a co-counselor (One Male and One Female). You will reside in a cabin or tent with campers each week. There are scheduled off site trips that will require tents or shelters. Prior experience with teens, hiking, outdoor camping, and summer camp is a plus. These positions require you to work with the Program Director, your co-counselor to plan, organize and coordinate the group's activities. The position requires a strong role model, in good physical shape, with good leadership, creativity and dedication.

TEEN SERVICE CAMP COUNSELOR (RESIDENT CAMP)

Description: Service camp is a program that allows grades 8 through 10 to learn and participate in service projects throughout camp and in nearby communities. Days are spent working on tasks and chores in camp, two off site trips per week to perform community service out reach. Campers also participate in scheduled camp activities throughout the week. Counselors will work with a co-counselor (One Male, One Female), Program Director, other staff and volunteers to plan and carry out on site and community projects. Service Camp Counselors are expected to be positive role models, community service minded and a willingness to participate in activities. Maintenance and grounds keeping experience a plus. **Be advised that some service projects require manual labor!**

CAMP COUNSELOR (DAY AND RESIDENT CAMP)

Description: This position requires you to be a positive role model to campers, be a true team player within the camp community, with high energy. Provide assistance to the Camp Directors and Day Camp Counselors and Specialists during the day. Assist the Camp Directors and Cabin Counselors in the evening and through the night. Provide assistance in all aspects of programming, supervision, chores and daily duties. This position requires program responsibility, general problem solving, planning, and structuring free time, skits, singing, dancing, acting, and a desire to work in an outdoor environment. Monitor campers during meals, pool and waterfront activities. Will include camp sign in and out and assist in transportation tasks. **Life Guard Certification is a plus!**

AQUATICS COORDINATOR

When: May 28, 2019 to August 23, 2019

Minimum Age: 21 years of age

Special Requirements: High School Diploma, Water Safety Instructor or YMCA Equivalent preferred, Lifeguarding, Scheduling Pool and Water Front Activities. Experience and knowledge of basis pool, filtration and grounds keeping tasks is required, Clean Driving Record (May transport campers)

Salary: \$300.00 to \$350.00, Residing on-site 6 Days, off-site 5 Days

Benefits: Meals, Housing if residing on site 6 days, off- site 5 days

Description: This position is required to oversee the pool and water front activities. The candidate will need a currant Life Guarding Certification, knowledge of basic pool maintenance, schedule life guards, activities, and oversee the swim lesson mastery program for campers. Aquatics staff including the leader must maintain daily reports on water testing, conduct swim tests for campers and visitors, and maintain a clean and well organized environment. Must be an active member of the camp leadership team, work with directors, staff and volunteers to deliver a quality aquatics experience for campers and visitors. Pool and Water Front times will be in 60 to 90 minute blocks, Monday to Friday. Some weekend groups may require pool or water front coverage. **Hours very due to additional responsibilities such as; sign in, sign out, transportation or bus stop duties.**

LIFEGUARD

Special Requirements: Current Life Guard Certification, Ongoing in-service

Description: This position requires a current lifeguard certification and some experience with camp water craft. Life guards are expected to serve as life guards for all camp activities at the pool and water front. Must be a positive role model, work with the aquatics coordinator, camp directors, staff and volunteers to ensure a quality and safe aquatics program. Help to maintain all pool and water front equipment, conduct pool water tests, maintain clean, organized aquatics environments (some maintenance and grounds keeping required). Pool and Water Front periods will be scheduled by the Program and Day Camp Directors with input from the Aquatics Coordinator, some evening and weekend coverage will be needed. **Hours will very due additional responsibilities such as; sign in, sign out, transportation or bus stop duties.**

Description: This position will require a knowledge and willingness to learn, plan and implement outdoor and adventure based activities and games for day, resident, and visitors to camp. Develop and carry out Camp Activity Plans to ensure campers, staff and volunteers are physically active and engaged. Be a positive role model, work with camp directors, staff and volunteers to promote safe and energetic activities. Must have knowledge and skills to implement plans for: team building, challenge course, hiking, fishing, water craft, marksmanship and outdoor activities. Instruction periods will be in 60 to 90 minute blocks, Monday to Friday. **Hours very due to additional responsibilities such as; sign- in, sign- out, transportation or bus stop duties.**

CHALLENGE COURSE AND TEAM BUILDING COORDINATOR

Special Requirements: High School Diploma, Experience or willingness to train to Operate the camp's low ropes and challenge courses, a knowledge of team and confidence building activities, clean driving record (May Transport Campers)

Description: This position will require the ability to operate and instruct campers, staff and visitors in the Ropes, Challenge Course, Team and Confidence Building activities. Candidate must accept the camps Full Value Contract of Safety, No Negatives and always be supportive. Work with campers from age 5 to 16 years of age. Maintain Activity Plans, Daily Use and Inspection Logs and equipment inventory. Activities will be scheduled with groups from Monday to Friday in 1 to 2 hour time blocks. Description: This position will require the candidate to have a knowledge and ability to develop activity plans and deliver lessons in the field of Environmental Education to campers ages 5 to 16. Must be a positive role model, willing to work with camp directors, staff and volunteers to enhance knowledge and understanding of the environment, earth related and recycle programs. Instruction will be scheduled in time blocks of 60 to 90 minutes, Monday to Friday. **Hours very due to additional responsibilities such as; sign in, sign out, transportation or bus stop duties.**

ARTS AND CRAFTS SPECIALIST
