REGISTRATION POLICIES

- You must be a Y member at the time of registration and throughout the duration of your child's camp enrollment to receive member pricing.
- Weekly fee includes lunch and afternoon snack (City Center only). Lunch and snack not provided first and last week of camp.
- **YMCA Financial Assistance is available for those who** qualify. CCIS accepted at our City Center YMCA summer camp.
- The registration fee is due at the initial registration. Payment for registered weeks must be either paid in full or set up at the welcome desk for auto-draft at time of registration. If you do not register for all weeks in advance we cannot guarantee registration for your child.
- After registering for your camp weeks, you'll receive an email with a link to ePACT - a secured data collection system.
- You will be given directions on how to complete the camp paperwork for your child through the ePACT system. We will not be sending camp paperwork in hardcopy form.
- ELRC copay \$10 first child and \$5 for each additional child in family.
